Safe Driving & Prescription Medications

Some drugs can:

- Slow reflexes and slow reaction time
- Cloud judgment and dull senses
- Increase confusion and anxiety
- Increase distraction and drowsiness
- Affect short-term memory
- Cause blurred vision

How to prevent impaired driving:

- Learn to recognize the kinds of drugs that can cause impairment (pain pills, sleep meds, etc.)
- Take prescriptions only as directed by your physician
- Avoid mixing prescription meds with alcohol
- Sharing prescriptions is both dangerous and against the law
